


## **NEWSLETTER - December 2024**

Our foundation has been participating in this leading international competition for quite some time in the form of the Jan Pustjens Press Prize. More than thirty international participants presented themselves in the City of Light. Our board member Arnold Marinissen was once again chairman of the jury. For this edition, we have made € 2,000 available for the compulsory work Box Office by Martin Fondse and David Dramm, composed especially for the final. The three finalists carried out this work during the final, entirely at their own discretion. Else Broekman and Sjoerd van den Berg were present. It was a pleasure to hear and see the work, the enthusiasm of the percussionists was overwhelming!

### Jan Pustjens Focus Day 1 February 2025

Now that our foundation celebrates its tenth anniversary in 2025, we want to give an extra accent to this Focus Day by creating a day around 'Drums of the World'. We hope to reach a large, broad and varied audience. We have found leading musicians from the percussion world willing to make this day something special.

The masters during this tenth and final Jan Pustjens Focus Day are Lucas van Merwijk, Simone Sou and Dominique Vleeshouwers. The presentation is once again in the hands of our board member Herman Rieken. During the day, workshops are given to students from all conservatories in the Netherlands.
